Teacher is All Aboard “STEAM” Train in Afterschool Club Project

Teacher Bill Sakalaucks supervises his 40 students, ages 8-11, in packing up their model railroad displays to exhibit as part of the new Trainfest Builders program at Trainfest 2019 to be held at Wisconsin State Fair Park, November 9-10, in Milwaukee.

The third through fifth graders are part of the Schulte Train Club launched by Sakalaucks, a general music teacher, at Schulte Elementary School of the Racine Unified School District.

The children have worked collaboratively to design and build the model railroad displays.

Trainfest Builders is an educational outreach program initiated by Trainfest in 2019 and sponsored by Wm. K. Walthers to bring a STEAM education to life through model railroads.
